

Minutes of the Regular Bradford Township Meeting
7:00 p.m. Monday May 8, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by John Hass. Justin will see what he can do to smooth out the area west of the ball field.

Bryan suggested we purchase flag display stands for the flags.

Bids for road projects were opened. Rum River was the lowest. Bryan Hathaway moved to approve the Rum River proposals. Tim Swanson seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
