## Minutes of the Regular Bradford Township Meeting 7:00 p.m. Monday August 12, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Richard Hansen. Steve Hass from Hass Construction asked if we would share with Springvale Township the cost of fill and rock to solve a muskrat problem on 325<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Richard Hansen moved to approve. John Hass seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Roanoke needs gravel and possibly a ditch and culvert in one area. This cost will be shared with Spencer Brook Township.

Xeon Street, Jeff Engquist's road, will be graveled after it is surveyed.

Bryan Hathaway reported on the progress of the Whitetail building project. He and Justin will coordinate landscaping.

Justin Anderson reported he has some of the culverts and is waiting for the rest.

Orv Halvorson reported that there is junk in the ditch near 30133 Palm Street NW.

Justin has installed the speed limit signs near Captains.

Isanti County Investigator, Wayne Seiberlich, reported on drug status, thefts, and fraud in Isanti County.

John Hass has the Lake Francis signs. Justin will install them.

Isanti Fire Chief, Al Jankovich, reported on charges for services provided by the Fire Department. He also stated there is a state program called Revenue Recapture that helps government entities collect bad debts.

It was decided not to pre-buy propane for this winter.

The primary election was discussed.

Richard Hansen reported on the weed inspection tour.

Isanti County Commissioner, Greg Anderson, reported on the progress of work on County Road 5, the start of the 2020 budget meetings, broadband grants, tax forfeited land sales, the feedlot ordinance, and the one watershed one plan meeting.
